**On Saturday, March 27th:
“A REMARKABLE MARY”**

This musical, stage production about Mary Magdalene and her relationship with Jesus is written by Hank Beebe and presented by Portland’s *St. Luke’s Players*. Though there is very little recorded in the New Testament about this Mary, Beebe has fleshed out a compelling story about her, through a combination of his research and conjecture. The chancel production features a 25-voice, choral ensemble, directed by Nancy Beebe and accompanied by the composer himself on the concert grand piano in Immanuel’s beautiful Sanctuary. Because it takes place on **Saturday, March 27th**, Palm Sunday Eve, the performance is a very appropriate way to enter into Holy Week, providing a rich and vivid context for the life of Jesus.
